You have worked with so many amazing people, who was the best to work with?

I have been so blessed to work with some incredible artists in my career. I worked with Bill Paxton on a movie when I was 16 years old and will never forget his kindness and beautiful spirit. Matthew Modine was fantastic. Jake Gyllenhaal and Ed Zwick were delightful. But it was my "Awkward" family that really holds a special place in my heart. That was such a talented cast, and they remain family to this day.

What is up with your producing career?

Producing and writing is something I've wanted to do since I was really young. These last few years have finally given me the time to write and develop. I took some time off from acting because I was pregnant with my second child, and he was born with a heart defect. He had to have open heart surgery at five days old and just had his second open heart surgery two weeks ago. I wanted to be home as much as possible. These last two years have been the most difficult of my life and I've also experienced great blessings - one of which was being at home and finally having the time to write and develop. Now, luckily, it's become a big part of my career. The last Hallmark movie I did I also produced which was so fun!

What was growing up in the south like?

Like growing up in a place where everyone knew your name. You are raised by a community of people, which is a beautiful thing. The whole town was a playground. Our parents didn't have to worry about bad things happening to us because everyone knew each other and was always on watch. We stayed outside playing until the sun went down. I had bible study, church camp, my dad as a basketball coach, playing in the woods, teachers that really cared...it was heavenly.

Our Editor In Chief has a PHD in sociology, tell us about your studies in sociology?

That's amazing! I love hearing that. I spent two years studying sociology and then had to shift majors when I changed schools. Sociology has impacted the way I see the world forever. What advice do you have for people who want to pursue an acting career?

Love it so much that you are willing to ride the roller coaster because it's a long and often difficult career choice. There are very high highs and very low lows. Find a community of artists who will support you in your journey. I found that at Warner Loughlin Studios in 2007. The people I met then are my dearest friends still and we support each other always. Find other ways to support yourself financially...things that will also bring you happiness and joy. You cannot depend on this business for your happiness. It will always disappoint. Finally, do the work, stay humble, maintain a good attitude, and give back any time you get a chance.

Do you back any charities?

Yes!!! I am a spokesperson for both Children's Hospital Los Angeles and The Alzheimer's Association. It brings me tremendous joy and fulfillment to be able to help organizations that are literally saving the lives of others. I feel you need to give back any chance you get.

What's up next for you?

I'm back into developing both for Hallmark and other networks. Also, I'm continuing to work with my blog What We Are. It's for a community of women looking to celebrate their beautifully unfiltered selves: the good, the messy and the sometimes painful.
