What was your favorite look from today's photo shoot for Runway?

When do you release your new album T.K.O.?

My new album T.K.O. (The Knock Out) will be released on Friday, April 20th on all digital outlets worldwide, with standard, autographed & personalized copies exclusively available on myamya.com/shop

How is this different from your previous Grammy Nominated album Smoove Jones released in 2016?

Smoove Jones is a traditional R&B album with more influences from the 70's with mid-tempos, up-tempo and a few slow jams. T.K.O. is a contemporary R&B album album with no up tempos, just mid-tempos and slow jams with a relaxing vibe and more current sound fused with feel good 90's R&B.

You just celebrated 20 years in the music industry on February 14, 2018. What do you feel is your greatest accomplishment?

Learning so many aspects of the business of music & wearing several hats behind the scenes without going absolute crazy has been quite an accomplishment. (laughs) Whether it be playing the role of manager, road manager, accountant, agent, lawyer, travel agent, engineer, producer, choreographer, musical director, stylist, hair stylist, make-up artist or seamstress, I've been more than willing to step into all of those shoes to get the job done and when I do, no matter how exhausted or frustrated, I'm often satisfied & happy with the final product and growth each obstacle instills. And with this relentless mindset & action, being able to serve, teach, help, encourage, employ and empower others has been the greatest accomplishment.

How does it feel to celebrate 10 years of your own independent label Planet 9?

10 years for a business is still pretty young, and I'm still building, but I can say that delivering 9 independent projects in my 10 independent years has truly been something I am really proud of because of what it takes to do so even on a smaller, boutique level. I haven't celebrated yet, because I'm already working on the next project. (laughs) But I am forever grateful for so many supportive people I've been fortunate to be aligned with.

When and where will you start touring?

I'm just returning from the U.K. and the next stop will be New York City on April 27th. All performance dates will be posted on myamya.com/events

What was one of your favorite moments in your career?

I have quite a few, but Michael Jackson calling me in the recording studio to not only wish me a happy birthday, but sing me happy birthday takes the cake. I was in complete, speechless shock.

Who is your biggest influence and why?

Lately my biggest influence has been Mother Nature or the natural world as it pertains to my existence on earth and humanity in its current state. I often wonder who I and who we as humans as a whole would really be in our natural divine environment at our highest frequencies prior to materialism, money, politics, religion, corruption, division, famine, war, etc., all created by man. I'm a fairytale dreamer of global peace but with the current state of the world, it's very hard to sleep. What can I do to make this place better?

It's been so amazing to see how my fans have reacted to this song which is the most authentic one I've released to date. It's currently 45 on the pop chart and I couldn't feel more grateful for that.

Who is your biggest influence?

Gwen has always been a huge inspiration for me because she is so unique. She never followed what everyone else was doing around her. She was a risk taker and performer that no one could compete with. Like young Gwen Stefani, Lady Gaga is a risk taker and such a huge inspiration to me. She is the epitome of an artist.

What's it like being a radio host on Sirius XM show "Hits 1 in Hollywood"?

I pinch myself every single day that I get to have a platform with over 30 million listeners to be able to have an opinion and be a voice for young women. I love connecting with others and that is definitely an important quality to have as a radio host. When you're speaking to so many different types of people and personalities you need to be able to connect with every single person on a different level. It's truly inspiring to hear some of my biggest influences stories when interviewing them such as Selma Hayek.

What is your favorite type of music?

All music inspires me in different ways. Jazz, classic rock, 70's funk, 80's Hair bands, 90's grunge, and pure pop!

Do you have any advice for upcoming artists?

Most important thing is honing in on your craft and being amazing at what you do. Practice nonstop and don't compare yourself to others, keep following your dreams! You have to be willing to work your butt off and social media can be a huge alley to new artists now. YouTube can do huge things for talent.

What's up next for you?
