We did that show for almost 5 years until I left to get into politics and start my Kasem Cares foundation.

Because my father experienced elder abuse late in life and he was isolated from all of his family and friends I decided to do something about it. People don't realize that once you turn 18 in this country you have no rights to see your parents if there is an uncooperative caretaker. That caretaker could be a spouse, sibling, lawyer, a person with power of attorney or guardianship. So, I have been going state to state with legislation my team and I created that protects our elderly and keep families together. We have passed our bill in 12 states and nine other states that have adopted similar versions.

I love TV as well and I'm getting back into it. Soon I'll be announcing a new TV show I was just hired for.

You asked the question about what was the hardest thing I've ever done and I'd have to say working for the UFC. Going live in front of millions of people and being in the octagon as the post-fight interviewer asking questions to the fighters just after the fight. Exhilarating and terrifying at the same time!

#### What's up for the rest of this year?

My three radio shows I do weekly. One being a syndicated mortgage finance show called "Get Mortgage Fit" for New American Funding, another is a law show called Gurvey's Law with super attorney Alan Gurvey and a show called "Driven" with Albert Preciado. Once in a while, I do a show called Red Carpet Radio for Cumulus heard on over 300 stations on the biggest Award Show red carpets in the country.

I've been working on a documentary for the last five years that follows my journey with Kasem Cares and the Kasem Wright Coalition fighting elder abuse and changing the laws in this country. We have followed a few families for a couple years and we show that isolation and financial elder abuse doesn't just happen to people with famous last names who happen to be rich but that this type of abuse can happen to anyone whether you have a dollar in your bank account or \$100 million in your bank account.

### If you had a tiny elephant to put in your purse, what color would it be?

I would like it to look as real as possible, I love elephants! So, it would need to be gray with beautiful white tusks. I love karaoke! When I was a kid I wanted to be on Broadway. The last year and a half I have gotten back into singing with a musical theater class taught by Broadway legend Carole D'Andrea and I've been having a blast! Also, GAME NIGHTS! I have a super competitive group of friends and we go at it!

#### Tell us about your pets?

My 20-year-old cat is my life, Kiddy! And about four years ago a stray cat that I had been feeding for years moved in with me, Azrael. He was named after the mean cat in the Smurfs but he has turned out to be the most cuddly, sweet, wonderful cat ever!

My entire childhood up in to my 20s was spent riding horses and my horse was my best friend. Because I travel so much I cannot have another horse quite yet but I will definitely have horses again.
