What was your favorite look from your Runway cover shoot and why?

The Malan Breton black dress because it made me feel like I was the black swan from the ballet Swan Lake.

Do you attend any global fashion weeks or runway shows?

I have attended New York Fashion Week, London Fashion Week, Arab Fashion Week and L.A. Fashion Week. I absolutely love fashion – the art, the story, the emotion behind it reminds me so much of WWE and the shows we put on. Going to runway shows inspires me in so many ways and I have pulled a lot of inspiration in my wrestling gear from fashion shows and designers.

Who are your favorite red-carpet fashion designers?

I have so many; I guess it depends on what red carpet it is and what the vibe of the event and carpet is. A couple of my favorites for red carpets include, Charbel Zoe, Aadnevik, Ralph & Russo, Malan Breton, Rami Kadi, and Jeremy Scott.

Ever since I was a little girl, Versace was my favorite designer and I dreamed of wearing a custom designed Versace dress on the red carpet. Now my dream is to wear Versace custom designed wrestling gear. I want to be the first person to really bring fashion into the WWE. We aren't just athletes; we are also entertainers putting on one of the most entertaining shows in the world.

Tell us about your personal style.

I believe your style should say something about yourself without saying a word. There are lots of different sides of me – I love to dress up and be very glamorous and ravishing and that is the side of me you see when I come out on Monday Night Raw as the "Ravishing Russian." I also travel 300 days of the year and love to be comfortable. So, I have developed a street style that is cool sweats, boots, jackets, and beanies. I love comics and Star Wars, so I wear a lot of comic tees & beanies. I started to combine my Ravishing/glamour style with my street style – I'll pair a comic t-shirt with a dressy skirt, and a designer belt. I can dress it up with high heels or dress it down with sneakers. If I have to do press, instead of wearing a suit & blazer with a blouse, I pair it with a Star Wars shirt. I feel that I'm expressing something about myself without saying anything. That's what your style should be – a reflection of yourself.

Is there anything in your closet that you cannot live without?

My Louis Vuitton collection of bags. I think it's very important to invest in timeless pieces. Louis Vuitton bags and luggage are timeless, and the leather only gets better with age.

Describe yourself in three words.

Risk-Taker, Ravishing, Resilient.

What is it like being a WWE Diva?

Four years ago, they changed our performer titles from "WWE Divas" to "WWE Superstars." The men were always called Superstars, but the women were called Divas. I'm so grateful I was able to be a part of history

when they decided to start calling women Superstars. Women should be called Superstars because we are Stars. This showed the world that women should have all the opportunities that men are offered. It gave me hope to fight for all human beings no matter what gender or sexual orientation you are. We all deserve an opportunity to pursue our dreams. It's an honor to be a Female WWE Superstar because in the past four years we have been able to make history in so many ways, from having the first-ever Women's Royal Rumble to main event Wrestlemania, to the first-ever Women's Tag Team Titles. I was able to be one of the first female performers in Saudi Arabia with WWE which isn't just making history for WWE, this is making world history. They told us we would never go to Saudi Arabia, but we did! We proved them wrong! We shut our naysayers and doubters up. This is showing little children & human beings from across the globe that you can do ANYTHING you set your mind to! It's an incredible feeling as a female WWE Superstar to know that we are breaking down barriers, shattering glass ceilings, and that the sky is the limit.

Tell us about your recent wedding to Bobby Lashley live on WWE.

Well, it was the most talked about & the most ravishing TV wedding in history. I was able to make history closing out the decade for WWE with my wedding! I couldn't be more grateful. My wedding dress was an amazing designer

How did you get started in acting?

For as long as I can remember, I dreamed of telling stories and entertaining the masses. I minored in acting in college & I started taking serious acting classes in LA right after college. I still take acting classes & improv classes; I love learning and working on my craft. It's so important to love the journey. The journey is our life story.

What is your favorite experience acting?

That would be a toss-up between playing Gwyneth in Another Version of You, which is now available on iTunes, and being the Ravishing Russian on Monday Night Raw on the USA network. I absolutely love being a villain and the Ravishing Russian is the greatest villain of all time! She should be winning every villain award out there! Haha.

What is the most rewarding part of your work?

Being a villain who can control a crowd & make people boo & hate me so much that no matter who comes out to face me the place erupts with cheers because they want to see anyone come and kick my ass. Knowing that I have the power to influence 100K people in a stadium. I am giving them their hero to cheer for and love. Sometimes I wish I would get a big THANK YOU from fans for being such an epic villain, but I realize it comes with the territory of being one of the greatest villains of all time.

Where did you learn to dance?

I started dancing with my Mommy at three years old. I was always choreographing dances. At 9 years old, I auditioned for the Latvian National Ballet Academy where I started dancing 40 hours a week. I started to dance professionally as a ballerina at 11 years old.

How about singing, tell us about how you got into that.

In college, I was offered the chance to audition for a girl group NeYo was putting together. They loved that I could break dance in heels, so they asked me to sing and I sang "Jesus Loves Me" and I got hired.

What's a typical day like for you?

Waking up early to catch a 6am flight to the city we are having a show in. We land, get a rental car, go to the gym and work out, come to the arena early and get in the ring and have wrestling training. Then I go and do my own hair and makeup for the show, do the show, then drive 4 hours in our rental car to the next city for a show the next day. I'm very grateful I get to do what I love for a living.

Where do you go to relax?

When I'm not working, I sleep a LOT! I try to make up for all the lack of sleeping I do when working. I love to binge on TV shows; it's so relaxing to me and I find much inspiration from it.

Do you have pets?

I have two dogs! Joy and Pickles! Joy is a Pomsky and Pickles is a Teacup Pomeranian. You can follow them on Instagram @JoyBarnyashev

What is your favorite kind of food? And do you need to stick to any certain diet wrestling?

My favorite type of food is Mexican. I am obsessed with chips and salsa! I would eat it every day if I could!

How do you stay in shape?

I switch my workout styles a lot, but currently I'm doing a form of CrossFit training 4 days a week. It's about 45 minutes long and I go hard the entire time with lighter weights and more reps. I do the elliptical 2-3 days a week for an hour; I put on my favorite show and just go. I also do hot yoga about 2-3 times a week which completely detoxes all the toxins from the body and the stretching just makes me feel so much better. If I ever want to get on the leaner side I up my days on the elliptical.

Any beauty secrets you'd like to share?

Wash your face with a great face wash every night, every morning, and after every workout. Always use a good moisturizer.



Tell us about your personal style.

Because I'm petite, I tend to gravitate to more classic lines, especially for the red carpet...pieces that fit well and don't overwhelm, with some fun, elegant or sexy flare. In my daily life, because I spend a lot of time in the studio standing in front of the mic or in rehearsal working on auditions, scene work, theater, coaching clients, or running around town from session to session, I lean towards clothes and shoes I can move a lot in: jeans, boots, and playful tops.

Tell us about your time in Paris.

I grew up in the United States on the East Coast, but my mother was from Denmark, and we spent a lot of vacations there when I was growing up. I always felt a deep resonance with Europe. When I was a teenager, I yearned to go back there to live and study.

As people often do at that age, I was struggling to figure out who I was, what I wanted in life, what I cared about... I was very drawn to France and their rich language. The art, culture and beauty of Paris somehow really called to me and I went there to study for a year, immersing myself in the language and lifestyle and exploring parts of myself I had less access to in the States. By some unforeseen providence I was invited to be an apprentice dialect coach at a studio that specialized in training French actors to act in English for movies and TV. I had an uncanny proclivity for it, and was offered a full-time job as one of their main coaches the following year. Faced with choosing between going back to the States to get my psychology degree, or following this new adventure doing something I loved and living in this beautiful city that so called to me, I put my psychology degree on hold to stay in France. From there, I spent two years working at this studio, ended up coaching many famous actors privately for projects in English, and coaching on sets as well. I was offered a role on one of the TV shows I was coaching on, got an agent, and decided to continue my acting training at Le Conservatoire National d'Art Dramatique de Paris, the most prestigious acting school in France at that time. I studied Racine, Moliere, and even Shakespeare in French, working hard to perfect my French accent so I could do more theater, movies and TV in French. To make extra money along with dialect coaching, I started doing voiceover, dubbing French films into English which led to an abundance of work in animation, video games, commercials, and fun projects like recording guided tours of the Louvre and the Musee d'Orsay in English. I married a Frenchman, and my one year in France turned into a 16 year acting career, voyage of self-discovery, and cherished home in the City of Lights.

What are your favorite designers for the red carpet?

I have a particular penchant for Herve Leger because his dresses fit the petite frame so well, and I love a lot of Karen Millen's pieces.

What is your most favorite thing in your closet?

I have a beautiful, very French, elegant Dior-reminiscent dress by Adelyn Rae that I wish I could wear every day. Casually, I

have colorful sweater-wrap from Lucky Jeans that my artist Dad gifted me when he was 85. I also have a collection of playful faux-fur jackets that make me smile.

What do you do for fun?

I am blessed that acting, the thing I spend most of my life engaging in, also happens to be my biggest passion and source of endless fun. Outside of that, one of my greatest simple joys in life is swimming. People say I must have been a mermaid in another life, because I often feel more at home in water than on land. Everything gets so quiet in the water, problems melt away, and I can hear the quiet voice of my heart much more clearly there. I also love spending time with dear friends in intimate, deeply human conversations, soulful connections and wonderful uncontrollable laughter. And dancing!

Tell us about your shoe collection.

Aside from sneakers, all the rest of my shoes are heels. Even boots. Paris is an excellent training ground for walking in heels. And I really love Steve Madden and Michael Kors.

Which fashion week is your favorite?

I focus so much of my energy into all the TV, film, theater and voiceover work I'm involved in, which requires hours of rehearsals, learning lines, studying other actors, other shows, working with coaches, writing, journaling, coaching others... that I don't have the time to follow Fashion Week very closely. But if someone offered me an invitation to go back to Paris for a fashion week there, I would joyfully accept.

Where do you go to relax?

I really like the simplicity of being in my apartment surrounded by my dad's paintings, warm music and my sweet kitty. I spend so much time on the road, on sets, jumping from studio to studio, that I don't get as much quiet time at home as I'd like. It helps me center and literally come back home. I also love being near water anywhere in the world, walking on the beach, sitting on a dock gently swaying above the waves with my feet in the water, or out in the middle of a lake on a boat.

What are your favorite colors?

Teal, Burgundy, and Soft Rose.

Do you still study psychology ?

Acting invites an exploration into the human spirit and human nature day in and day out. But as an actor, it's less about analyzing anything as much as it is about diving into the human heart and human condition to reveal raw, honest resonating truths and realities that may resonate universally. As a dialect and acting coach, I imagine there is psychology involved, but I relate to all of that in a more intuitive, spontaneous way without too much conscious analyzing. Outside of acting, I've always been kind of a seeker, and I read a lot of books related to mysticism, human evolution, personal development and the sacred.

What is your favorite movie?

Here are a few: Francis, Five Feet Apart, Nell, The Diving Bell and the Butterfly, The Wizard of Oz, The Matrix, What's Eating Gilbert Grape, and Finding Nemo.

What's up next for you?

I just shot four different TV shows this Fall that I can't yet talk about, as well as some really cool video games. I'll also have the exciting worldwide release of Tom Six's bold new film The Onania Club, and a really fun new play called Slap Kiss Kill, which I will be performing in Los Angeles this year.

Oh that's so hard to answer! I have sporadic taste in music – I went to see Neil Diamond at the Hollywood Bowl a few years ago and just saw Lizzo in concert a few weeks ago!

How did you get started in acting so young?

Starting in 1st grade my school competed in Odyssey of the Mind, which is a worldwide creative problem solving competition that has a performance component... I think that's when I was first bitten by the acting bug. I got really into it in middle school, and then I studied musical theatre at a wonderful performing arts high school in Miami, New World School of the Arts, and I also started working at one of the local theaters, Actors' Playhouse in Coral Gables. Around 14, I started bugging my parents to let me look for an agent and pretty soon I was auditioning for all of the Disney and Nickelodeon stuff that was happening in Orlando, and I got my first two TV jobs while I was in high school. The rest is history!

What movies or TV's influenced you?

When I was really young, I was OBSESSED with Wizard of Oz, Annie, and Sound of Music. I think those were definitely the beginning of my love for musical theatre. Beyond that, I loved comedy - the sillier the better. I loved Mel Brooks movies, especially Spaceballs. I knew Spaceballs inside out before I ever saw Star Wars, and then when I finally saw Star Wars years later, I laughed through all of it because I was finally getting all the references from Spaceballs. That being said, I then became a HUGE Star Wars fan. I started watching SNL when I was 6, and I loved The Muppets, The Simpsons, and classic 80's sitcoms. Perfect Strangers was one of my favorites! My husband and I entered our wedding reception to the theme song from that show! It's comedy perfection, and they don't make shows like that anymore!

What's your work diet like?

I try to be as healthy as possible in general. I'm not very hungry earlier in the day after I have coffee (which is a must). I'll usually eat a lot of fruit and try to have some clean protein like eggs, and then salad for lunch because if I eat any heavier than that,

I know I'm going to crash and get so sleepy! I'm also a huge hoarder of snacks! If there are snacks around, I usually grab a bunch and keep them for later on in the evening when I get a snack attack. I know that's the worst time to eat a bunch of snacks, but that's the only time I want them!

Do you like to cook?

I don't, and I wish I did! I think I might feel differently if I had a really nice kitchen with a lot of space, but in my current situation cooking just feels stressful.

What's your favorite fruit? How about vegetable?

That's so hard because fruit has always been my favorite thing ever since I was little. I love stone fruits like peaches and nectarines. I go crazy in the summer when those are in season. I love cherries and figs, but they're so expensive! In New York I would buy a carton of figs from the fruit stand (they're much cheaper there) and eat them all in one sitting. I love all the melons - watermelon, cantaloupe, honeydew... all of them! For veggies, I just love salad. Any kind of salad, but I don't like fruit in it! I'm also very happy about this brussels sprouts renaissance we're having. I love that a vegetable that traumatized our parents has been turned into something delicious and trendy!

How old where you when you moved to New York? Was it a shock?

I was 18, and in retrospect, it feels like an insane thing to do. I didn't know ANYONE. I was living in a studio apartment with two other people. My mom left me in the aforementioned apartment sitting on the floor surrounded by subway maps. It was a huge adjustment, but I'm so glad I did it when I was so young. There's something to be said for the naiveté of youth when it hasn't really occurred to you yet that there's anything you can't do. If I had done it a few years later, I would've been a nervous wreck!

My musical film, Marriage Material, is still appearing in festivals and will be featured by Fox Searchlight shorts this month, which means everyone will finally be able to see it! I shot another episode of Future Man for their third and final season and that should come out sometime this year, but I don't know the release date yet. My husband produces a bi-monthly live musical show featuring magic and puppets called The Astonishing Show Show!, and I co-write and perform in that as well!

What's your number 1 goal?

I'd love to be a series regular on a TV comedy show!
